Hello Neighbors and Friends,

With the partial re-opening of restaurants, retail stores and other businesses, we are beginning to see a glimmer of light at the end of the COVID-19 tunnel. Social distancing of at least 6 feet apart and the use of face masks in public places continue to be touted by medical experts as an important way to inhibit the spread of this highly contagious disease. Your adherence to these guidelines not only helps to keep you safe, but also those around you, many of whom may have compromised immune systems.

As you know, we continue to experience shortages of certain items including toilet paper, paper towels, hand soap and hand sanitizers. Once taken for granted, these supplies are important for our health and wellbeing, especially during COVID-19.

We recognize that Village of Tequesta residents who are 65 years and older may have more challenges obtaining these goods. To assist our seniors, The Tequesta Friends of Public Safety (see* below) and the Village of Tequesta have joined together to provide limited quantities of these hard to find products at no charge to our senior population. A generous donation from Lindsay Mesches at State Farm Insurance has made this possible. Off-duty firefighters and police officers, and volunteer members of the Tequesta community will be assembling the packages and delivering them to the doorsteps of those who have requested the supplies. Estimated time for the program to begin is the week of June 1, 2020.

We will be preparing well over 400 packages for delivery to our seniors. If you are a Village of Tequesta resident and are 65 years or older, I encourage you to take advantage of this program. In addition, we know that some of our seniors may not have access to the Village's website (www.tequesta.org) or Facebook page. If you have a neighbor or friend that qualifies for the program, please reach out and let them know what is available to them.
