Residential Knox-Box Program

The Residential Knox-Box is a high security key safe that only local emergency responders can access.

The Knox-Box Residential Program is ideal for individuals:

- With a history of medical problems
- Recuperating for a hospital stay
- Living alone
- Using an electronic calling/medical alert service
- Seasonal Residents

The Knox-Box Residential Program enhances the Fire Department's response times.

With a Residential Knox – Box installed, emergency responders can respond quickly without forcing entry. It allows responders to enter a home unassisted thus preventing forced entry damage and added stress to the patient. They simply remove your entrance key stored inside the Knox-Box, provide medical assistance and re-lock your door when they leave.

With a Knox-Box there is no need to hide a key or rely on a neighbor to be home when an emergency strikes. A hidden key can be found by a burglar.

There are a number of different models to accommodate your needs. Authorization forms with the available models are located at Tequesta Fire Rescue. Prices vary according to the model that you choose.
