Palm Beach County Emergency Order #3 Amendment Directing Safer at Home

Palm Beach County [Order 2020-003a](#), became effective today, March 30, 2020, at 12:01 a.m. The order STRONGLY URGES residents to stay home or at their place of residence, except to obtain necessary services and supplies as outlined in [Section 7 a-e](#) of the Order.

Palm Beach County and Governor Orders

Retail and Commercial Business

Palm Beach County [Emergency Order Number 2](#), [Section 3](#), closes all **noncritical retail and commercial business locations within Palm Beach County** (incorporated and unincorporated) except to the extent necessary to perform minimum basic operations. The businesses deemed critical are outlined in [Section 4](#).

Restaurants and Food Service

Per the Governor’s [Executive Order 20-70](#), restaurants and/or food service business establishments (with seating for more than 10 people) can only remain open to provide delivery services, pick-up and take-out.

Docks, Ramps and Marinas

Palm Beach County [Emergency Order Number 1](#), as amended, closed all boat docks, ramps, marinas and other venues utilized for launching any vessels to be used for recreational purposes, including but not limited to fishing charters, boat tours and diving excursions.

The Village asks that everyone please comply with these orders for the safety and wellbeing of our residents. The Building Official will be enforcing the Orders through the legal means allowed. Palm Beach County COVID-19 Testing Site

Telephone registration and appointment scheduling for COVID-19 testing began today (Monday, March 30) and runs from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Individuals requesting a test will be approved through telephone screening conducted by The Healthcare District of Palm Beach County.
