

## PESTICIDE REGULATIONS

Application of pesticides (which include herbicides, fungicides, insecticides) by businesses and their employees is regulated by the Florida Dept. of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS). For your health and safety, insure that any business and/or their personnel applying pesticides on your lawn, plantings, driveway, walks or anywhere on your landscape is properly trained (has taken and passed a state exam) and is licensed or certified.

Other key provisions of Florida law regulating Pest Control & Pesticide use outside the home on landscapes include;

- Lawn maintenance companies **cannot** make pesticide applications (including weed-n-feed applications) to lawns.
- Company personnel applying herbicides (including Glyphosate-based products like Roundup) on your planting beds, driveway or other surfaces must be properly trained and certified by the State of Florida.

Note: Tequesta recently passed a Resolution to eliminate the use of Glyphosate-based pesticide products on all Village public property.
