


Q1 Are you a resident of the Incorporated Village of Tequesta and eligible to vote in the municipal election?



Q2 How long have you been a resident of the Village of Tequesta?







Q4 Overall Satisfaction with Village Services by Major Category





Q8 Village maintenance issues that should receive the most emphasis over the next two years (Select your top 3 preferences).






