

BUSINESS IMPACT ESTIMATE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES AT CHAPTER 2. ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE V. ELECTIONS, DIVISION 1. SECTION 2-234 “ELECTRONIC FILING OF CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS” TO ALLOW THE VILLAGE TO OPT OUT OF PROCEDURES FOR THE ELECTRONIC FILING OF CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS WHEN REQUESTED BY THE VILLAGE CLERK; ALSO AMENDING DIVISION 2. SECTION 2-251 “INSPECTORS; OTHER ELECTION WORKERS” TO ADD THE PALM BEACH COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS AS BEING AUTHORIZED TO APPOINT POLL WORKERS FOR VILLAGE POLLING PLACES; PROVIDING THAT EACH AND EVERY OTHER SECTION AND SUBSECTION OF CHAPTER 2. ADMINISTRATION SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Part I. Summary of the proposed ordinance and statement of public purpose: Ordinance 02-25 authorizes the Village Clerk to opt the Village out of the process for electronic filing of campaign reports for municipal election candidates. It also authorizes the Palm Beach County SOE to appoint poll workers to polling places in the Village.
