

BUSINESS IMPACT ESTIMATE

As required by Sec. 166.041(4), *Florida Statutes* (2024), this “Business Impact Estimate” is provided for Ordinance No. 01-25:

ORDINANCE NO. 01-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE TEQUESTA CODE OF ORDINANCES AT CHAPTER 30. ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL. ARTICLE X. NOISE. SEC. 30-361. PROHIBITED NOISE GENERALLY. TO REVISE THE PERMISSIBLE HOURS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND OTHER NOISE GENERATING ACTIVITY ON SATURDAYS; PROVIDING THAT EACH AND EVERY OTHER SECTION AND SUBSECTION OF CHAPTER 30. ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL. ARTICLE X. NOISE. SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Part I. Summary of the proposed ordinance and statement of public purpose: Ordinance 01-25 revises hours for construction activity that generates loud noise and changes the permissible hours for such noise generating work on Saturdays.

Part II. Estimate of the direct economic impact of the proposed ordinance on private, for-profit businesses in the Village of Tequesta:

a. Estimate of direct compliance costs that businesses may reasonably incur if the proposed ordinance is enacted: None. The ordinance does not prohibit noise generating construction work on Saturday; it only shifts the permissible hours in conformance with neighboring jurisdictions.

b. Identification of any new charges or fee on businesses subject to the proposed ordinance, or for which businesses will be financially responsible: None. There are no fees associated with the proposed Ordinance.

c. An estimate of the Village of Tequesta’s regulatory costs, including an estimate of revenues from any new charges or fees that will be imposed on businesses to cover such costs. None. The Village of Tequesta will incorporate the ordinance into its existing Code Enforcement activities, and as such any costs are minimal, if any. Violators will be subject to code enforcement fines in accordance with the Village Code and Florida Statutes.
