



Village of Tequesta 2025 Tree Rebate Program Guide

- Participants must submit the registration with aerial image of property indicating tree location, distance from nearest structures, species and size.
- Upon receipt of complete registration, Staff will review and provide funding verification and approval.
- Participants must provide receipts indicating size and species of tree and contact Staff for a visual inspection after planting to receive reimbursement.

Application window:
Oct 1–Mar 1 (or until funds are gone)

Funds are distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis

Annual funding cap:
10,000 Rebate max per tree: \$300 (Tier 1) or \$200 (Tier 2)

Eligibility limits: up to 2 trees per homeowner, 5 per HOA

Reimbursement will be for the cost of planted trees, up to the specified denomination

Funding is not secured until participants receive funding approval from Staff

Program Restrictions

Trees must be planted within Village Limits and on property owned by the applicant

Trees required by Village landscape plans or mitigation requirements are NOT eligible

Trees May NOT Be Planted

Within 10' of any building foundation or sidewalk

In utility easements or drainage swales

In ANY location that could obstruct traffic visibility

In locations not previously approved by the Village of Tequesta
